

Pope senior NCO wins interservice chess tourney

POPE AIR FORCE BASE, N.C. (AFNS) - A senior NCO assigned to Pope Air Force Base recently defeated top chess players from each service to take home the top prize during the 2010 Interservice Chess Championship.

Master Sgt. Dan Ranario, of the 3rd Aerial Port Squadron, will join the U.S.-led team participating in the 2010 NATO Chess Championship.


"It was really exciting to do so well in this year's tournament because this is my last year competing," Sergeant Ranario said. "I will be retiring this year, so I'm glad that I will get to be a part of the U.S. team and hopefully we will do well in the NATO tournament."

As a boy growing up in the Philippines, Sergeant Dan Ranario had his first encounter with the game of chess when his father, an avid chess player, sat him down and taught him the rules of the game.

"I started playing chess when I was 10 years old, and again in 2002

when I was re-introduced to the game by Col. Samuel Echaure, (Sergeant

Ranario's former mentor)," he said. "He really encouraged me to get

involved in the military tournaments and playing with him made me better."

Sergeant Ranario has been honing his chess skills for the past nine years, and is ready to face the competition.

Sergeant Ranario said he is preparing for the international competition by practicing at home, playing online games and reading chess books.

Now, years later, that initial training will prove valuable as Sergeant Ranario, along with several others, takes his place on the U.S. chess team -- a spot given to the top finishers from each service.

"I feel very special and privileged to make the cut," he said. "Not everybody gets to represent the U.S. chess team."

In order to gain a spot on the team, Sergeant Ranario competed at the base level, the Air Mobility Command level, the Air Force level and finally at the interservice level where he competed against the top players representing the Navy, Army and Marines.

"It's awesome to know one of your Airmen is out there doing their best and representing the Air Force so well," said Maj. Ketchum, the 3rd APS commander. "How often do any of us earn the right to represent our country at a NATO competition? It's a great accomplishment. I think (Sergeant) Ranario can bring home the gold for the U.S."

Sergeant Ranario is the only Pope AFB member to earn a spot on the team this year, a distinction he has earned six times before. He has also made the Air Force chess team seven times previously.

"I am extremely thankful that my squadron gave me the time off to compete in the tournament," he said. "My squadron, Pope (AFB Airmen) and AMC leadership have been incredibly supportive of me and helped me get to where I am in the chess tournaments. With all we have to do and with deployments nowadays, it's hard to get away sometimes, but they have really worked with me. I would have never gotten as far as I have without their support."

The U.S. chess team will travel to Koege, Denmark to compete in the 21st NATO Chess Championship scheduled Oct. 18 through 22.

ND soldiers monitoring the skies of Iraq

U.S. DIVISION-NORTH, IRAQ — Despite the drawdown of troops in Iraq, about 60 North Dakota National Guardsmen remain. Eight of those serve with the 1st Battalion, 188th Air Defense Artillery Regiment and are led by Sgt. 1st Class Michael Kraft, of Devils Lake, N.D. The Soldiers support a wide range of daily operations in U.S. Division-North, Iraq, utilizing the Sentinel Radar on two separate bases in the 3rd Infantry Division-led USD-North.

When they first arrived to Iraq, the Soldiers were separated among four locations. The North Dakota Guardsmen all worked in multiple Brigade Air Defense and Air Management, or ADAM, cells

spread throughout northern Iraq. Sgt. Matthew Shere, of Duluth, Minn., is the Sentinel Radar noncommissioned officer-in-charge at Forward Operating Base (FOB) Warrior, near Kirkuk, where he reflected on his mission: "The mission has been a great success thus far, and it's nice to know that we are an integral part of daily operations."

Throughout their time in Iraq, the Soldiers of the 1-188th ADA's mission is to utilize the Sentinel Radar to coordinate and deconflict airspace throughout Iraq. This includes deconflicting aircraft, mortar fire missions, unmanned aerial systems, controlled detonations, close air support, attack weapon teams, show of force missions, troops in contact, countering indirect fire, and conducting air assault missions. This long list of demands has kept these Soldiers extremely busy and impressed a countless number of people along the way.

While Shere and his team remained at FOB Warrior the entire year, the others have returned to Contingency Operating Base (COB) Speicher to work in the 3rd Infantry Division Air & Missile Defense section. It's an around-the-clock job in which the Soldiers monitor airspace for outside missile and aircraft threats to U.S. Division-North.

The ADA Soldiers in Iraq mobilized Nov. 30, 2009, along with a sister Sentinel Radar group of about 25 that are serving in Afghanistan. Additionally, the ADA has a group of about 40 Soldiers serving in Afghanistan with the Rapid Aerostat Initial Deployment, or RAID, system. They are all expected to return home this fall from the yearlong mission. When in North Dakota, the ADA is headquartered in Grand Forks, with units also in Bismarck and Fargo.

Corn Chowder

- 3 medium ears fresh corn
- 1 (4 ounce) piece unsliced bacon, rind discarded and bacon diced
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 1/2 large red bell pepper, diced
- 1/2 teaspoon fresh thyme or 1/4 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1/8 teaspoon turmeric
- 1 pound all-purpose potatoes, peeled and diced
- 3 cups reduced-sodium chicken broth
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- Coarsely ground black pepper
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch, dissolved in 2 tablespoons water
- 1 cup half and half
- Minced fresh chives or thinly sliced green onions, for garnish

1. Cut kernels off cobs and scrape off milky bits. You should have about 2 cups corn. In a large pot cook bacon until crisp. Pour off all but 1 tablespoon fat. Add butter, onion, bell pepper, thyme, cumin and turmeric; cook over medium heat until vegetables are tender. Stir occasionally. Add corn, potatoes, broth, salt and pepper. Cover and bring to a boil. Adjust heat and boil 10 minutes or until potatoes are tender. Stir in cornstarch mixture and cook until chowder is lightly thickened. Stir in cream. Garnish with chives or green onions. Makes 4 main-dish servings.



Lecture highlights First Lutheran cemetery and research

Findings from summer research conducted at Minot's First Lutheran Church cemetery on Broadway, and at a military fort near Mitchell, SD, will be shared at a presentation Monday, September 13, at 7:00 p.m. in the Aleshire Theater, MSU, as a part of the Northwest Art Center Lecture Series.

MSU faculty Dr. Margaret Sherve and Mark Timbrook,

assisted by student participants in the two projects, will present "MSU Students Dig (into) the Past: Cemetery, Archaeology, and Service Learning."

Students Jay Jenkins and Misty Neumiller spent much of June working in the northwest quadrant of the First Lutheran Church graveyard; they will report their findings in the dirt and in the

archives. The work of these students will set the stage for an additional research class during the summer of 2011.

Five students participated in the first MSU archaeology field school at a military fort on the James River south of Mitchell, SD. Kelsey Eaton, Alexandria Fancher, Gregory Gould, Turqoyz Rogahn, and Kathryn Materi spent two weeks in July learning

about archaeology and mid-19th-century military forts. Students will describe procedures, structures, and artifacts. A question and answer period and informal reception will follow. The program is free and open to the public. After 5 p.m., parking on the MSU campus is unrestricted and open to the public.

The Northwest Art Center Lecture Series is funded in part by a grant from the North Dakota Council on the Arts, which receives funding from the state legislature and the National Endowment for the Arts.

Airmen, veterans, and beneficiaries who were involuntarily extended under Stop Loss between Sept. 11, 2001 and Sept. 30, 2009 are eligible for Retroactive Stop Loss Special Pay (RSLSP). If your enlistment was involuntarily extended due to Stop Loss, and you have yet to file a claim for RSLSP, the last day to file is October 21, 2010. Go to www.afpc.randolph.af.mil/stoploss for links to the claim forms and instructions on how to file.




