U.S., Australian military participate in Exercise HAMEL in the 'Land Down Under'

JOINT BASE PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM, Hawaii - U.S. Air Force B-52 Stratofortresses supporting U.S. Pacific Command's Continuous Bomber Presence in the Asia-Pacific region flew from Andersen AFB, Guam, to the land 'down under' to demonstrate the capability and flexibility of the Stratofortress to Australian military partners, as part of Exercise Hamel, Oct. 8 through 18. Participation in Hamel and similar exercises provide an opportunity for Airmen to engage with allies and regional partners, and ultimately contribute toward interoperability, regional stability and security.

"It's a great opportunity to interact with our coalition partners and sister services throughout the Pacific AOR [during exercise Hamel] to train together, learn from

each other, and remain proficient at our mission and show U.S. resolve within the region to protect and defend our allies from any potential adversary," said Maj. James Greenfield, bomber liaison officer, 613th Air Operations Center, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam.

The long-duration flights, normally lasting between 11 and 13 hours, allowed the aircrews from the 23rd Expeditionary Bomb Squadron, assigned to the 36th Wing at Andersen AFB, to team up with Australian joint terminal air controllers to conduct close air support training. During this year's exercise, 12 sorties were flown in direct support of the training.

"Such training provides a valuable opportunity for our forces to work together and hone their skills," said Wing Commander Ian Honey, Royal Australian Air Force, assigned to the 613th AOC's Strategic Guidance Team

here.

This is the sixth time US-PACOM bombers have participated in exercise Hamel. B-2 Spirit bombers completed the first Hamel exercise from Guam in July 2006, while the

first group of B-52s completed their first exercise Hamel sorties with the Australian military in October 2006.

Thirteenth Air Force is one of four numbered air forces in Pacific Air Forces. It

is located at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii, and provides oversight of two Air Force Wings, one air support operations group and 12 additional units in Japan, Alaska and California.

Eerie Halloween Treats

Spooky Graveyard Pie

Makes 8 servings

- 3 cups (about 32) finely ground chocolate sandwich cookies, divided
- 3 tablespoons melted butter
- 1 can (12 fluid ounces) Evaporated Milk
- 1 3/4 cups (11.5-ounce package) Milk Chocolate Chips
- 2 large egg yolks
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 8 chocolate filled vanilla wafer cookies
- Black and purple decorator writing gels
- Assorted Halloween Candies



COMBINE 1 1/2 cups cookie crumbs and butter in 9-inch pie plate. Press crumb mixture onto bottom and upsides of pie plate. Set aside remaining 1 1/2 cups crumbs for dirt topping.

WHISK together evaporated milk, egg yolks and cornstarch in medium saucepan. Heat over medium-low heat, stirring constantly, until mixture is very hot and thickens slightly; do not boil. Remove from heat; stir in morsels until completely melted and mixture is smooth.

POUR into crust. Sprinkle with remaining 1 1/2 cups cookie crumbs. Press crumbs down gently. Refrigerate for 3 hours or until set.

DECORATE cookie tombstones with writing gels as desired; let set. Insert tombstones around edge of pie. With spoon, mound cookie crumbs to form "fresh graves." Decorate graveyard with candy to make the pie as spooky as you want it to be!

Spiderweb Munch

Makes 12 servings

- 2 cups (12-ounce package) Semi-Sweet Chocolate Morsels
- 1 cup creamy peanut butter, divided
- 1/3 cup powdered sugar
- 3 cups toasted rice cereal



HEAT morsels and 3/4 cup peanut butter in small, heavy-duty saucepan over low heat, stirring constantly until smooth; remove from heat. Add sugar; stir vigorously until smooth.

PLACE cereal in large bowl. Add 1 cup melted chocolate mixture; stir until evenly coated. Place on ungreased baking sheet. Using small metal spatula, shape into 10-inch circle with slightly raised 1-inch-wide border. Pour remaining chocolate mixture in center of circle; spread to border.

FOR SPIDERWEB:

PLACE remaining peanut butter in small, heavy-duty plastic bag. Cut tiny corner from bag; squeeze to pipe concentric circles on top of chocolate. Using wooden pick or tip of sharp knife, pull tip through peanut butter from center to border. Refrigerate for 30 minutes or until firm. Cut into wedges.

North Dakota's newest soldiers give back during 'Guard the Environment'

FARGO, N.D. - The North Dakota National Guard Recruit Training Battalion took a break from training for a community clean-up project in Bismarck, Fargo and Devils Lake this weekend. The event, called 'Guard the Environment,' was part of a National Guard Bureau-led initiative to give back to the communities that support service members while emphasizing the importance of caring for the environment.

"This is our way of thanking the community for all it has done for us and returning the favor by giving back," said Sgt. 1st Class Christopher Hjelseth, readiness noncommissioned officer for the Fargo Recruit Training Company.

The Recruit Training Battalion is comprised of Soldiers who have not finished their initial National Guard training. This includes Soldiers who have either not yet shipped to Basic Training or who have not completed Advanced Individual Training, both of which Soldiers must pass before joining their designated unit.

The battalion is divided into three companies - one each in Bismarck, Devils Lake and Fargo - as part of the Recruit Sustainment Program concept created by the National Guard to help suc-

cessfully transition Soldiers through training.

Each recruit company, with more than 30 Soldiers apiece, went to a community location on Saturday to perform a task to better the environment.

"We should show the initiative that the environment is just as important as school and work, and we can't just let it go to waste," said Pvt. Shannon Holeton, of Fargo, who recently returned from Military Police Advanced Individual Training. "It would be nice to see other people doing their part to show they care."

Each location was given the option to choose where they wanted to conduct the community clean-up, but the three locations worked together to choose a specific weekend to hold the event.

"I want all Soldiers to know they can help the community and do the right thing," Hjelseth, of West Fargo, said. "If we all work together, we can accomplish a lot in a short amount of time."

The Fargo company chose to spend two hours picking up trash around North Dakota State University.

"Many of our Soldiers attend NDSU, so choosing to help clean up NDSU was a great way for us to let NDSU know the recruits and students are willing to help clean campus," Hjelseth said.

The Devils Lake company helped the community by raking leaves and picking up

trash at local parks.

"The National Guard is committed to conserving the environment that we live in. This is our way of giving back to our state, country and world," said Staff Sgt. Randy Raasch, of Hettinger, N.D., a platoon sergeant with the Recruit Training Battalion.

In Bismarck, new Soldiers spread out at the Bismarck State College Community Bowl to trim trees, collect trash and rake leaves.

"We took 47 recruits and cadre down to the Community Bowl to assist the

Bismarck Park Board," said Sgt. 1st Class LeRoy Mittleider, of Bismarck, readiness noncommissioned officer for the Bismarck Recruit Training Company.

"The recruits were brief Saturday in regard to how the military's training areas have been affected in the past from our training and what we are currently doing to correct the past damage to restore our training areas and help our environment through our efforts. Based on feedback, all who were involved with this event thought that it was a great idea to do our part to restore the environment and would like to see more environmental activities conducted throughout the year to help out our local communities and the environment."

The Recruit Sustainment Program is incorporated into the National Guard of all 54 states and territories, and each battalion was responsible for holding an event to help clean up communities.

Since the 2001 terrorist attacks on America, the North Dakota National Guard has mobilized more than 3,500 Soldiers and more than 1,800 Airmen in support of the Global War on Terrorism. Currently, about 75 North Dakota Guardsmen are serving overseas while more than 4,000 remain in the state for emergency response and national defense. For every 10,000 citizens in North Dakota, 65 serve in the North Dakota National Guard, a rate that's more than four times the national average.




