

Operation Round Up helps volunteer organizations

The Burlington Fire Department depends on dedicated volunteers, reliable equipment and strong community support to save lives and property. Because of the department's dedication to serving the community, it was an ideal organization for an Operation Round Up grant from Verendrye Electric.

The department was recently awarded a \$1,500 grant to purchase new helmets for firefighters. Although volunteers hope they don't need to use them often, the helmets are absolutely necessary to protect the firefighters from falling debris and hot flames.

"We've got to be ready for anything," said fire chief Karter Lesmann.

The Burlington Fire Department has 25 firefighters and eight junior firefighters. The department responds to 50 to 70 calls per year and covers a 90-square-mile area. The department is one-hundred percent volunteer and is always seeking new members.

The fire department and 18 other organizations were awarded a total of \$16,450 in Operation Round Up grants this fall by the Verendrye Electric Trust Board. Operation Round Up is supported by Verendrye members who voluntarily round up their monthly electric bill to the nearest dollar, generating thousands of dollars each year to be given to communi-

ty-minded projects and people with medical expenses. Since 1996, Operation Round Up has awarded 710 grants worth \$624,267.

Like the Burlington Fire Department, a number of grant recipients are organizations that depend on volunteers. The Minot Railroad Museum, located in a historic building in downtown Minot, is one of them. The Museum was awarded a \$500 grant to make improvements to its heating system. The grant is a good fit for the museum because they just happen to have a volunteer who is an expert in heating and cooling. Roger Burchill, who retired from Minot State University after 30 years working in the heating plant, now spends many hours doing maintenance and upkeep at the museum.

Burchill appreciates the grant because the museum operates solely with donations and grants. Many people have donated money or materials to the museum and it is maintained entirely by volunteers. Burchill has a crew of volunteers working on a renovation of the upstairs, where visitors can access a library, and see railroad artifacts dating back to the 1800s. Volunteers also spend many hours helping clean the museum. Burchill said new volunteers are always welcome.

2. Heat a large nonstick skillet over medium-low heat. Place sandwiches, buttered sides down, in skillet. Cook 5 minutes on each side or until golden brown. Serves 2.

Northwest Art Center lecture traces french influence

The Northwest Art Center Lecture Series presents "French Visions of Overseas Power: Private Enterprise, Technology, and Ports in Japan, Argentina and Africa, 1880-1939" by Dr. Daniel Ringrose, Professor of History and Chair of the Division of Social Science at Minot State University, Monday, November 8, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the Aleshire Theater, MSU.

Where and when did European empires end and modern nations begin? What did "global" work mean to skilled workers in the early twentieth century? How did France, a country that labored in the

shadow of England and the United States through much of the twentieth century, establish and retain such a vibrant Francophone presence around the globe?

To explore these questions, Ringrose introduces the audience to the "edges" of the French empire.

French engineers and skilled technicians built ports, railways and factories that left a physical legacy, created economic ties to France, and cemented a reputation for French prestige and technical prowess that lasted well into the twentieth century. Ringrose joined the faculty of MSU in

1995. He currently teaches a variety of classes on European history, France, social history, history of technology, environmental history, Asia and imperialism. His areas of concentration include modern France and Germany, gender history, technology, professionalization, empire, elites and problems in labor history.

The lecture is free and open to the public. A question and answer period and informal reception will follow the lecture. Parking on the MSU campus is unrestricted and open to the public after 5 p.m. For more information about Northwest Art Center activities, call 701-858-3264.




