One device saves lives, time, money

Most people think aircrew members only have to worry about the aircraft when flying. Rarely do people recognize the importance of altitude changes and how it can affect the aircrew member's physiology.

"Hypoxia, essentially, is a reduction of oxygen supply," said Capt. John C. Lavin, 5th Medical Operations Squadron aerospace and operational physiology team chief.

Symptoms include headaches, fatigue, shortness of breath, a feeling of euphoria and nausea, he added.

Experiencing hypoxia while flying is something Air Force Global Strike Command aircrew members need to train for so they know how to react and correct, said the captain.

To ensure aircrew members are prepared and know how to react if altitude changes induce hypoxia while flying, they train with reduced oxygen breathing devices in the flight simulator.

"The function of this device is basically to induce hypoxia and test the aircrew member's ability to react and correct," said Tech. Sgt. Keith Lewis, 5th Medical Operations Squadron aerospace and operational physiology technician.

The sergeant noted that before these devices were obtained last year, aircrew members used to have to go on TDYs to receive training in the altitude chamber.

"The difference between this device and the chamber is that with the device, we are changing the amount of oxygen they receive, which is virtually the same thing as changing the altitude," said the sergeant.

So why train with the reduced oxygen breathing device over the chamber?

"This device has several benefits over the chamber," he started. "First, this is more cost effective because we're not sending individuals on TDY, so it saves a few thousand dollars in TDY costs."

The breathing device is also more beneficial because of where it is used, he added.

"The training is accomplished inside of their working environment [flight simulator] as opposed to the chamber where members sit waiting for the change in altitude," he said.

"They [aircrew] are able to see how the hypoxia affects them while they are performing their flight tasks," the sergeant said. "Sometimes they realize they are engaging in hypoxia, sometimes they won't. This simula-

tion helps them recognize what happens and why hypoxia is so dangerous."

This device is a lot more physically beneficial than the chamber as well, he said.

"When they used to train in the chamber, they wouldn't be able to fly for days afterwards because of in-

tense fatigue," Sergeant Lewis added. "Now, with this device, aircrews are able to fly the same day they complete the simulation, which in turn allows the aircrew to continue with other required training."

Captain Lavin believes that overall, this training and this device are valuable tools in the accomplishment

of Minot's mission.

"I think this training is very beneficial," said the captain. "The aircrew members are able to learn their symptoms and the signs of hypoxia in their actual environment, while remaining in a safe environment where we can monitor their oxygen levels and pulse."

Butternut Squash and Tomato Bisque



- 3 1/2 pounds butternut squash (4 cups squash pulp)
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1 (28-ounce) can whole tomatoes, undrained
- 1 to 2 tablespoons maple syrup or honey
- 3 1/2 cups reduced-sodium chicken or vegetable broth
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

1. Preheat oven to 375F. Cut squash in half lengthwise. Place squash cut sides down in a roasting pan. Add water to depth of 1-inch. Bake 30 minutes or until tender. Scrape pulp from squash to measure 4 cups.
2. Heat butter and oil in a Dutch oven. Add onion; sauté 5 minutes.
3. Place tomatoes with juice in a food processor. Add maple syrup or honey; process until blended. Add butternut squash; process until smooth. Add squash mixture, chicken broth and salt to Dutch oven; stir well and heat through. Garnish with chopped tomato. Serves 8.

AT ensures housing residents are equipped

Minot Air Force Base Anti-Terrorism Office

The Minot Air Force Base Anti-Terrorism Office launched its 2010 campaign designed to better protect the installation and its resources from terrorist activity.

The Neighborhood Sensor Program is targeted at Air Force Global Strike Command base housing residents who live along or close to the base perimeter and is used to educate these residents on enhanced anti-terrorism measures and recognition of suspicious activity.

"The Minot Air Force Base Neighborhood Sensor program was devised to improve the awareness of base housing residents who live along the perimeter of the installation," said P.J. Pallotta, Minot AFB anti-terrorism officer. "Basically, we want our residents in those houses actively involved in the installation's overall force protection program."

Mr. Pallotta said the program has been very successful as it is the reason this base has overcome serious vulnerabilities in the past.

The Neighborhood Sensor Program greatly counters these security concerns by enlisting these residents to act as force multipliers. Residents accomplish this through sensors and patrols and by educating them on

what to look for when assessing a possible threat.

Some of the training and education residents received included:

1. Unclassified threats to the installation
2. Methods of entry by those groups or organizations that would attempt illegal entry
3. Training on recognizing and reporting suspicious activity
4. Deterrence methodologies
5. Additional actions during increased Force Protection Conditions

"Although similar to the Air Force Eagle Eyes Program, the Neighborhood Sensor Program progresses in that it targets certain personnel and provides specific training to ensure these residents are aware of their unique location and are capable of detecting and reporting suspicious activity," said Master Sgt. Billy Theel, base anti-terrorism officer.

"Once residents are trained, they will have the tools to better identify possible installation threats and provide early detection," Sergeant Theel added.
